

What You Need to Bring*

Please bring the following documents (only those persons for whom you are applying for coverage) to assist in determining eligibility for Kansas Medicaid, HealthWave, or a discounted fee for health care.

- **Photo Identification Card**
Please bring the following identification: Birth certificates, immunization records and social security card.
- **Any Health Insurance Information**
(If applicable).
- **Identification of Home Address**
Ex: Postmarked envelope within the last 10 days containing your name & address
OR a notarized letter from the home owner where you live, stating your current address.
- **Names of Family Members and their Dates of Birth**
Include immediate family members only: spouse and children.
- **Proof of Total Household Income**
Ex: Income tax statement, a notarized letter stating income, or a pay stub.

- Well baby check-ups and minor illness.
- Specialty care referrals as necessary.
- Most prescription medicines are free.
